DETROIT CITY (SWEET HOME) MINE TOUR

10AM (APPROX. 2 HOUR TOUR)

Thank you for your interest in this very rare opportunity to tour the Detroit City portal of the world-renowned Sweet Home Mine near Alma, Colorado. The Sweet Home Mine operated from 1873-1967 as a silver, lead and zinc mine. It reopened in 1991 as a rhodochrosite mineral site and famous specimens such as the Alma King have been found there.

This tour is hosted by the Mosquito Range Heritage Initiative and will be led by local mine geologist Dean Misantoni. The tour will begin at 10am on Saturday Aug 12. After a brief safety meeting our underground adventure will begin.

Given the small number of people the tour can accommodate, MRHI will conduct a drawing to randomly select participants. Only 10 spots are available, only 2 spots can be claimed per email entry. All participants must be current MRHI members. Participants chosen for the tour will be expected to pay the \$100 donation upon selection. All proceeds benefit MRHI and our mission of conservation, preservation and education within the Mosquito Range.

The deadline to enter the drawing is **Friday Aug 4th**. The drawing will be conducted on **Saturday Aug 5th**, with payment due by **Monday Aug 7th**.
